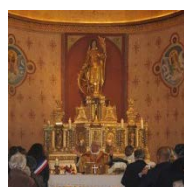


Editorial **Going back to school !**

For the new school year of 2016, we have joined forces with Castelnaud sur Gupie.

The annual cost which we have to pay (since we no longer have a school in the village) is 409.19 euros for primary school and 1,497.60 for nursery school. If parents want their children to attend a different school, they should discuss this with our mayor as any financial help will not exceed the above costs we pay to Castelnaud.

The former school building will be refurbished and incorporated in to a new Mairie as soon as all the competitive tenders have been received.



Our church will be open on 17 and 18 September for the Heritage Weekend. For those who missed the inauguration on 10 April 2016, it will be an opportunity to see the work which has been done and see the listed altar and the murals.

New in our commune **Park Griffon**

Jean-Christophe DUCCESCHI and his partner Vinciane CHARRIN have opened their superb 4.5 hectare animal park.

This park is intended to preserve certain species of animals and to allow you to see, play with and learn about them all.

There are about 30 species of animals in the park as well as play areas (a zip wire, bouncy castles, and swings) and a picnic area where you can buy drinks and snacks.

Minutes of **the Council Meetings**

From 18 December 2015, 22 January, 1 March, 8 April, 24 May, 28 June and 29 July 2016.

Actions or Decisions taken by your Council :

- ☞ The Council has agreed to investigate the possibility of joining a syndicate for insuring council properties.
- ☞ The Council has agreed to improve the remuneration of its two secretaries in the light of their increased duties, by 1153 euros per annum and 1492 euros per annum. These rates will be calculated in accordance with the number of hours each secretary works.
- ☞ To refurbish the former school house, the Council has decided as follows :-
 - M J L CASSE was chosen from 3 candidates to be the clerk of works.
 - The budget will be 84,776.50 euros.
 - The cave will be reorganised to allow us to store the tables and chairs for the Entertainment Committee.
 - A soil study costing 480 euros will be undertaken for a new sewage system.
 - A number of companies have tendered for the work.
 - Xavier Susanna (AFP) has provided a quotation of 1337 euros to make the cave watertight and to build a ramp to improve access.
- ☞ The Council has agreed a total of 2000 euros for the following subsidies for 2016:
 - Sports Association- Sainte Colombe - Duras -Levignac100 euros
 - Home Help 200 euros
 - Virazeil Convalescent Home..... 100 euros
 - Caubon Entertainment Committee 1000 euros
 - Caubon Hunt 600 euros
- ☞ The Town Planning Scheme (SCOT) was approved
- ☞ The accounts for 2015 were agreed and are as follows:-
 - Expenditure135,579.61 euros
 - Receipts.....428,173.90 euros
 - Investments made.....71,074.63 euros
 - Investments received207,729.94 euros
- ☞ Local taxes for 2016 will be the same as those for 2015.
- ☞ The provisional budget for 2016 was agreed
 - Expenditure and operating revenues355,136 euros
 - Expenditure and investment revenues275,334 euros.

Council Minutes **Continued**

Actions or Decisions taken by your Council :

- ☞ The commune will transfer 30 euros per pupil to cover the cost of transporting them to Duras. Muriel Delmotte and Catherine Bernard represent us on this committee.
- ☞ M Hubert TERRIGHI was elected the commune's road safety representative.
- ☞ A survey of the commune's roads will be undertaken in 2016/17.
- ☞ The Council accepts that the commune will meet the request of the label 'Bio-Territory' covering 110 hectares of the 609 hectares which are able to claim this label.
- ☞ The Council has purchased 110 second hand chairs for the church.
- ☞ The Council has purchased three more sets of Christmas lights.
- ☞ The Council has taken out a three year contract to protect our computers at an annual cost of 67 euros.
- ☞ Madame Christiane VACHE has been reimbursed by the commune for 87.50 euros as she has given up her 30 year concession in the cemetery.
- ☞ A new version of the PLU was accepted.
- ☞ The insurance contract with AXA will finish on 31/12/2016 and be replaced by The Public Sector Management Centre, costing 6.14% of salaries, rather than 7%.
- ☞ The Council agreed to the merger of the Drop-Aval and Dourdenne Unions.
- ☞ The law requires the security of the marquee to be checked every 2 years and this will be done at the end of this year.
- ☞ The Council will pay 4,120 euros for the schooling of 4 pupils at Levignac for 2015/16.
- ☞ The Council decided not to continue with The Council for Architecture and Town Planning.
