Minutes of **the Council Meetings**

From 23 September, 10 November, 16 December 2016, 8 February 2017, 24 March, 10 April, 30 June, 24 July, 1 September, 10 November et 11 December 2017.

Actions or Decisions taken by your Council :

- ☞ Works transformation the former schoolhouse in to the mairie; the projected cost was 84,776.50 euros and the actual cost was 76,348.81 euros
- ☞ The Council has agreed a total of 2000 euros for the following subsidies for 2016:
 - Sports Association- Sainte Colombe - Duras -Levignac100 euros
 - Home Help 200 euros
 - Virazeil Convalescent Home..... 100 euros
 - Caubon Entertainment Committee 1,000 euros
 - Caubon Hunt 600 euros
- ☞ The accounts for 2016 were agreed and are as follows :
 - Expenditure127,213.86 €
 - Receipts..... 363,112.78 €
 - Investments made127,544.69 €
 - Investments received289,514.32 €
 - ❖ excess = 397,868.55 euros + 2,768.17 euros for CCAS
 - ❖ resulting in 235,898.92 euros available for use
- ☞ The level of local taxes for 2017 remains the same as for 2016.
- ☞ The provisional budget for 2017 was agreed
 - Expenditure and operating revenues 383,814 euros
 - Expenditure and investment revenues229,566 euros.
- ☞ Management of the cemetery :
 - It is possible for people living outside of the commune to be buried in the commune providing they have a connection with families living in Caubon Saint Sauveur or that they or their families already hold a concession in the cemetery,
 - Steps will be taken to retrieve abandoned tombs. There will be notices on the notice board at the mairie, on the door of the cemeteries and on the relevant graves.
- ☞ Committee for National Social Action (CNAS) : an agreement has been signed within Lagupie to deal prorata with the costs and will be an item in the budget.
- ☞ Social Action Committee for the Commune (CCAS) : CCAS has been dissolved to make administration simpler and on the recommendation of the government treasurer. The commune will take responsibility in future and the surplus of 2,768.17 euros has been included in the council budget.
- ☞ Renewal of the participation of the Syndicat Mixte du Dropt Aval pour continue the battle against unwelcomes species in the Dropt and its tributaries. Jean Christophe Ducceschi and Christophe Fabre-Pinon represent the commune.
- ☞ Regarding the school Castelnau-sur-Gupie / Caubon Saint Sauveur ; Catherine Bernard and Cédric Guisiano have been designated to sit on the school council. The childrens' parents will be contacted regarding transport to the school. Note, the commune does not assist financially with the costs of any child educated in the private sector.

Council Minutes **Continued**

- ☞ Local Planning of Urbanisme (PLU) :
 - The commune wishes to maintain some ability on planning and opposes the transfer of this feature of the planning system to the Val de Garonne.
 - The commune's control over other aspects of planning has expired; nevertheless, the council wishes to wait until the PLU is in place.
 - There were no serious objections to the PLU and so the council decided to proceed with it.
 - Until the PLU is in place the the Val de Garonne is responsible for soil tests.
- ☞ Christmas illuminations : a quotation of 558.71 euros was accepted to put 3 lights in the village to add to the existing ones.
- ☞ It was noted the Barbaste should be allowed to join the water and sewage system of Syndicat Eau 47.
- ☞ The Centre de Gestion de la Fonction Publique Territoriale has enabled us to safeguard all the information stored in the mairie and a laptop has been purchased for the secretaries use in this respect.
- ☞ The amendment to the statues of Syndicat des Collectivités Electrifiées SDEE47 was approved.
- ☞ The councillors were insured on the same basis as the previous year.
- ☞ Mr Tom Allison was reimbursed in the sum of 172.55 euros for mileage incurred in his responsibility for the green spaces in the commune in 2016.
- ☞ The council found it unnecessary to entrust the classification of archives to the Centre de Gestion de la Fonction Publique.
- ☞ A survey will be done with Caubonnais to know if a bread distributor in the village would be useful.
- ☞ For security raison, we had asked Val de Garonne Agglomération to change the panels «give way» by panels «stop» at the bottom of « Paillet » and « Picard » and on all roads leadings to the RD 708.
- ☞ The activit report 2016 of VGA has been approved unanimously.
- ☞ An exceptionnal grant of 200 euros will be give to the « Les Bernadettes » association to realise the 21st edition of the Rallye 4 L trophy. During this rallye, somes school supplies will be given to Moroco school's.
- ☞ A motion of solidarity with the Departemental Council for the survival of rurality was voted.

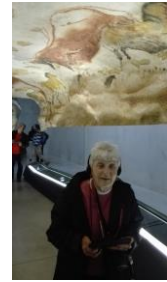


A good number of people from Caubon came and were treated to rum punch, followed by spit roasted chicken and roasted potatoes.
