This new site, in several languages, enables you to access many services and keeo u to date.

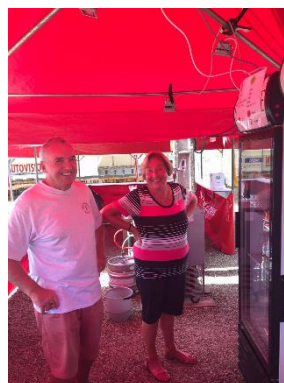


## Retour sur **La fête de Juin**

# Minutes of **the Council Meetings**

From 29 January, 26 February, 26 March, 12 April and 11 June 2018.

## **Actions or Decisions taken by your Council :**

- ☞ Agreement to the new convention of the management centre (CDG) which replaces three previous agreements.
- ☞ The village will pay up to 10 euros per month for additional cover for employees of the village.
- ☞ It was decided to ask for a second quote for solar energy panels.
- ☞ Regarding the school Castelnau-sur-Gupie / Caubon Saint Sauveur ; it was agreed to advance 6,500€ through Val de Garonne Agglomeration.
- ☞ Jean Christophe Ducceschi is our delegate for Syndicat Mixte Trec, Gupie and Médiér (water).
- ☞ Jean Christophe Ducceschi and Christophe Fabre were re-elected delegates of the commune to the Syndicat Mixte du Drop Aval.
- ☞ The new statute of the Syndicat Mixte du Drop Aval (water) were approved.
- ☞ The Council has agreed a total of 2000 euros for the following subsidies for 2018:
  - Sports Association- Sainte Colombe - Duras -Levignac .....100 euros
  - Home Help ..... 200 euros
  - Virazeil Convalescent Home..... 100 euros
  - Caubon Entertainment Committee ..... 1,000 euros
  - Caubon Hunt ..... 600 euros
- ☞ The level of local taxes for 2018 remains the same as for 2017
  - Taxe d'habitation at 8,93
  - Taxe foncière built at 12,68
  - Taxe foncière non built at 52,91
- ☞ The accounts for 2017 were agreed and are as follows :
  - Operating costs .....118,198.79 €
  - Operating receipts..... 398,669.71 €
  - Investments costs .....78,044.08 €
  - Investments receipts .....224,880.35 €
    - ❖ excess = 427,307.19 euros
    - ❖ resulting in 280,470.92 euros available for use
- ☞ The provisional budget for 2018 was agreed
  - Operating costs and receipts ..... 430,046 euros
  - Investment costs and receipts .....289,938 euros.
- ☞ The council have postponed the decision to insulate the house owned by the Mairie until a later date.
- ☞ The Council is considering:
  - Bringing the village hall up to the norms
  - To move the kitchen in to the former meeting room
  - The possibility of building a new village hall.
- ☞ For this purpose Lea Bonetti, architect at Tonneins and M. Novac were been approached.

## Did you know ▲ pastel Artist?

A pastel artist is someone who uses pastels for their works. They use a technique similar to drawing and painting with the aid of sticks of colour called pastels.

These pastels are made up pigments which can be dry (soft or hard) or greasy (oil or wax).



The pastel artist may use pure colours or mix them. You may know Latour, Degas, Toulouse-Lautrec or Delacroix who created works with pastels. Leonardo da Vinci, in the 15th century, used this technique which brought about the renaissance in France and in Italy to enhance drawings in black pen, chalk or red pen.

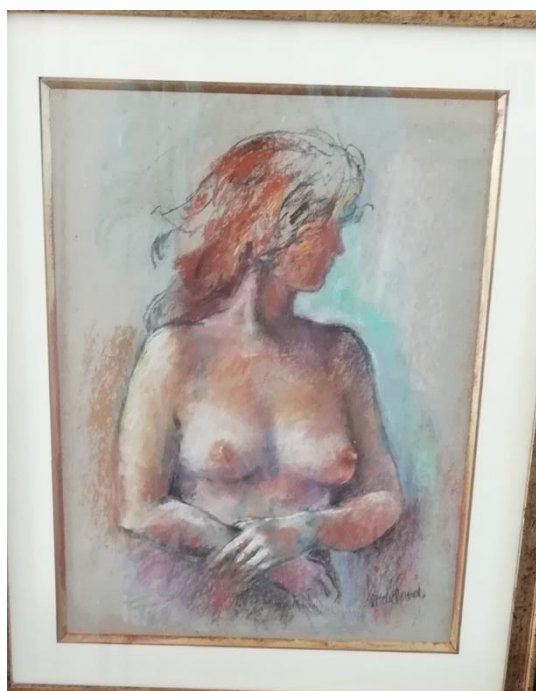
We had a good fortune to have amongst us, in Caubon at La Boulie, a master of pastels : Monique MARCHAND



Monique MARCHAND was born near Paris, of Eastern European extraction and she studied at Paris and at Versailles.

She wanted to become a designer but she eventually decided to become « an artist of nature ». During her 25 years in Caubon she won a number of distinguished prizes.

Her works are to be found in Holland and in the USA. She was a member of a good number of professional associations amongst them the Society of Pastel artists of France who named her Master Pastel Artist in 2003. She is known for her works of flowers, still life and country scenes.



Monique MARCHAND died on 3 June and left to the village the two paintings shown below. They are on view at the Mairie.



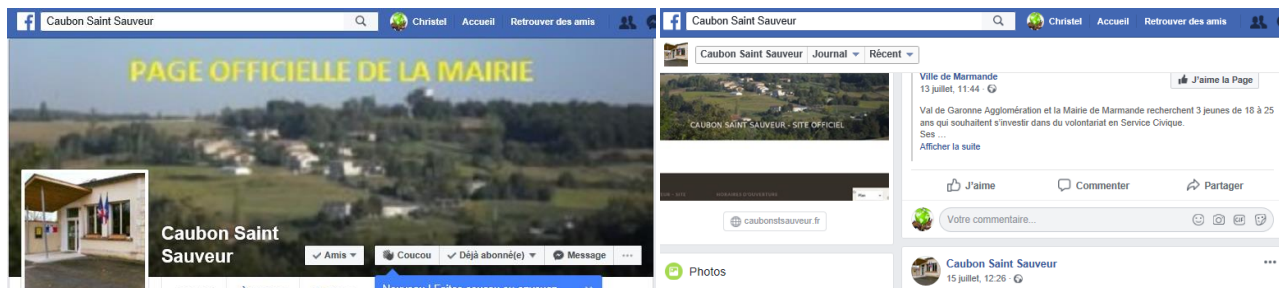
## Bear in mind **Living together**

Her grandparents, Emilienne & Joseph LANDREAU, farmers from the Deux Sèvres region, moved here in 1929 and bought the farm Ganucheau. Her parents, Marie-Josèphe & Norbert ROBIN had continued. Marie-France was born in 1946 and went to school in Caubon. In 1969, she married Noël POUGET and she had three children, Nathalie, Patrice and Véronique. Before she had her children, Marie-France was a teacher at the Maison familiale in Miramont de Guyenne. Thereafter she dedicated her life to her children, husband, and parents. Very active, she was secretary of the Basketball Club in Levignac, active member of CCAS, the entertainment committee and the parish of the village. An excellent cook, daughter, mother and grandmother to four grandchildren, always concerned for her family.

For 7 years she battled 3 different types of cancer. She won the first two battles but sadly not the last. She passed away on 24 March, having taken care to leave her family enough preserves to last them for the next three years.
